At the end of the training, candidates will receive a link to the SAFe Community platform and will be able to take the exam. The first test is included in the training within 30 days. Each new trial will then cost \$50, payable directly on the SAFe Community platform.

Following successful completion of the exam, the candidate receives their certification which is valid for 1 year. This must be renewed annually and costs \$100/year or through the SAFe enterprise subscription "SAFe Enterprise Subscription (SES)".
